The training of library manpower to move with the emerging trends in the information landscape remained yet another focus area for which DELNET made incredible contributions by organising numerous Webinars and training sessions during the year.

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III MEMBERSHIP

On the membership front, the year 2022-23 has brought in 653 new members to DELNET's network of libraries, strengthening its membership base and also the scope and coverage of institutions. These members joined from across the country. The states from where the maximum number of members joined included Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, etc.

It should also be noted that additionally 162 institutions (previously inactive) renewed their membership w.e.f. August 1, 2022 under DELNET's Special 30th year celebratory gesture.

DELNET continued with its best efforts to approach various institutions in India and outside for membership during the year. Efforts were also made to approach the major universities with affiliated colleges to explore the opportunity for networking and modernising their libraries. Some of these proposals are in the pipeline. The detailed breakup of DELNET membership is mentioned in Appendix I.

IV FINANCE

With the limited self-generated finances from the institutional membership fee which has not been increased for more than two decades now, DELNET continued to weave its success story of self-reliance and sustainability and providing equitable and affordable access to networked E-resources. DELNET remains dedicated to transform libraries and by investing its limited resources for the development of libraries and to offer the most reliable support to libraries and their users, comprising faculty, researchers and scholars.

V DELNET BUILDING

5.1 DELNET Hostel Block

During the year 2022-23, there was a marked improvement in the use of DELNET's guest house facility which was marred in the previous years due to the pandemic situation. It was used regularly by institutions for accommodation, conducting official meetings, seminars, workshops, etc. A number of universities including JNU, Central Universities, AICTE, IIMs, other Academic, Research and Special Institutions used the guest house facilities and greatly appreciated the services and support extended by DELNET.

The property tax for 2022 for DELNET, New Delhi was paid to the MCD. Also the property tax for DELNET Lucknow office was paid to Nagar Nigam Lucknow.

5.2 Purchase of DELNET Office Space for its Coordination Unit at Pune

I am pleased to inform you that DELNET has purchased the Office Unit 0-445, Boulevard Part of Towers, Phase I, Connaught Road, Sadhu Vaswani Road, Pune-411001 with Carpet Area 88.92 sqmetres (with additional balcony area of 23.35 sqmetres.) [Total Area 1208 sq feet] from BramhaCorp Limited, Pune, a leading 40-year old Real Estate Developer in Pune. The office is located in a prime, central location in Pune which is near the Pune Railway Station. The interior work will be started soon and DELNET will be able to run its Pune office from its own office premises. The Pune office of DELNET has been operating from rental premises for nearly one decade. It is worth mentioning that Maharashtra is the leading state with the maximum number of DELNET member-institutions.

5.3 DELNET Bangalore Coordination Unit Office – Interior Work

The interior work at DELNET Bangalore Office at Brigade Signature Tower has been in progress. The air-conditioning, electrical and networking work has almost been

completed. It is hoped that the entire work will be completed in the next few months and the Bangalore Unit would start running its operations from the new premises.

VI NETWORK OPERATIONS

6.1 DELNET Online Services

During the year, the member institutions used the DELNET online services regularly for searching the various resources. It is heartening to note that the member libraries have actively participated in “DELNET Best Practices - Data Sharing and Accessibility”. The services have been operational 24/7. DELNET also continued organising the Webinars/in-person orientation sessions for users’ community of the member libraries which has definitely helped in the effective utilisation of DELNET resources and services.

6.2 Internet Leased-Line with NIC

The DELNET-NIC 2 Mbps MTNL leased line connectivity is working effectively.

6.3 Airtel RF Internet Link

DELNET also has an Airtel 20 Mbps RF link for organising Webinars, backup data servers operations, etc. The link is working smoothly.

VII DELNET DISCOVERY PORTAL

7.1 It is worth mentioning that the DELNET Discovery Portal was upgraded with the latest application and OS version. Also new features were added in the portal for enhancing the users’ experiences. The member institutions made the best use of the DELNET Discovery Portal for searching around Rs. 3.8 crore resources of various member-libraries and also exploring various other E-resources offered through DELNET. The member institutions were encouraged to send the library records to DELNET for merging in the discovery portal and it issued “Certificate of Appreciation” to them.

It is also affirmed that DELNET has introduced a new feature in the discovery portal wherein the institutions can now selectively search their own contributed library records through their assigned location code. The member-libraries greatly appreciated the introduction of this feature which helps them in providing a “Web OPAC” to their own users as many of the libraries do not have their own Web OPAC facility for the library catalogues.

7.2 Knowledge Gainer Portal

The Knowledge Gainer Portal of DELNET provides access to more than 1.6 crore full-text E-books, E-journals, E-articles, etc. The users of member-institutions made full use of E-resources which were very popular.

5. LANGUAGE LEARNING

The Language Learning Portal was used extensively by the students of the member institutions which was a helping aid to them to learn English and other foreign languages both for improving their spoken and writing skills.

6. MANUSCRIPTS AND RARE BOOKS

DELNET also provides access to full-text manuscripts and rare books.

7. E-Newspapers

During the year, DELNET newly created a “E-Newspapers” section in the online portal which provides access to a sizeable number of E-Newspapers published in Hindi, English and other regional languages including Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Telugu, etc. The respective links to the newspapers are provided to the users.

VIII INTER-LIBRARY LOAN (ILL) AND DOCUMENT DELIVERY SERVICES (DDS)

The Interlibrary Loan and Document Delivery Services, a unique, fully functional and most reliable service to reach out physically to the resources lying scattered in the member-libraries, remains greatly utilised by the member-institutions. It is heartening to see that in the era of unimaginable E-content and E-resources, the dependability on physical books available in the libraries stays relevant. The strengthening of library-to-library cooperation and the resource sharing remains the priority areas for DELNET for which it contributes extensively. The services are in popular demand by the member-institutions which help their faculty, researchers and scholars to get the desired resources for their academic and research work. The support extended by the member-libraries for enhancing the level of resource sharing is praiseworthy and commendable. It is a great boon for the scholarly and research community. It helps in realising the mission of taking the Libraries to the places wherein users are located. DELNET continues to contribute significantly in this direction.

IX SOFTWARE SUPPORT

9.1 DELNET continues to offer valuable and appreciable support for the installation of Delplus, the library management software, provided free of charge to its member-libraries. A sizeable number of member-libraries across the country use the software which is installed remotely through Team Viewer software. DELNET also provides assistance to member-libraries for converting the existing library records into Delplus. The barcoding can also be done using Delplus.

9.2 Support for Open Source Software for Member-Institutions

DELNET continues to offer support for installation and customisation of Koha for library automation among member-libraries. The installation is done on Linux platform remotely.

DELNET also provides support to member-institutions for the installation of Dspace software for creating Institutional Repositories.

XI NEW INITIATIVES/PORTALS LAUNCHED

11.1 DELNET launches ViSiOn Portal and Best Practices for Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) Knowledge Sharing Among Member-Libraries

I am glad to inform that a highly sophisticated DELNET “ViSiOn” (Video Sites Online) portal is made live which contains many enriching video lectures delivered by the Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) in varied fields of knowledge and hosted and accessible through various institutions. The single window interactive, innovative and engaging platform allows the faculty, students, researchers and scholars, etc. to access the video lectures through Title, Subject, Speaker’s Name, Host Institution, etc. Also, “Browse by Category” option is available wherein the Video Lectures on various subjects including Agricultural Science, Architecture, Ayurveda, Education, Engineering and Technology, Languages, Law, Library and Information Science, Literature, Management, Mass Communication, Medical Sciences, Nursing, Pharmacy, Science, Social Sciences, The Arts-Performing and Visual Art, Yoga, etc. are made available. The member-institutions have welcomed DELNET’s new initiative and have started sending the video lectures of their faculty members. Nearly 22,000 video lectures are currently available through the ViSiOn portal, which is continuously updated.

11.2 DELNET Launches WebView – DELNET Video Channel on YouTube

During the year, DELNET has launched “WebView”, its video channel on YouTube. It contains the video recordings of the various Webinar sessions organised by DELNET. The LIS professionals, faculty members, students, etc. can subscribe to the Youtube channel free and can view the recordings of the past webinars organised by DELNET. The channel has started gaining popularity. As DELNET is committed to “Empower the Libraries and Inspiring LIS Professionals”, the DELNET WebView channel would significantly contribute in enhancing knowledge sharing among professionals and would lead to their professional development.

11.3 DrillBit: Plagiarism Detection Software for Academic Integrity

DELNET in collaboration with Balani Infotech Pvt Ltd. has started offering web-based DrillBit Software to its member-libraries for plagiarism detection for a subsidised annual subscription of Rs 48,000 (inclusive of GST) for 300 documents checking.

The DELNET Coordination Units in Bangalore, Hyderabad and Pune are functioning successfully. The work on online data collection, follow-up for membership renewals, new membership from the region, organising Webinars, etc. also continue from these Coordination Units.

XIII CELEBRATING 30 YEARS OF DELNET

I am glad to inform you with great delight and honour that DELNET has completed the significant milestone of 30 years of its pioneering work of Library Networking on June 30, 2022. “Networking Libraries, Sharing and Spreading Knowledge” remains DELNET’s prime objective for which it has worked relentlessly for the past three decades for Empowering Libraries and Inspiring Professionals.

13.1 The programme entitled “Celebrating-”DELNET@30: Forging Ahead in Empowering Libraries and Inspiring LIS Professionals” was held online on June 30, 2022. The librarians from member-institutions spoke about “DELNET: A Boon for Librarians, Academicians, Researchers and Scholars”. It was followed by discussions on ViSiOn and DESIRE Portals of DELNET. The day-long webinar was attended by 930 participants from various parts of India and outside.

13.2 It is noteworthy that as a special celebratory gesture under DELNET’s 30th year, it has provided a special offer to the inactive institutions whose membership has lapsed in the past to renew their annual membership from August 1, 2022. Under this special incentive, 162 institutions have renewed their membership under the special offer.

XIV NATIONAL INITIATIVES

NACLIN 2022

The 25th National Convention on Knowledge, Library and Information Networking (NACLIN 2022) was organised online on the theme “*Redefining and Repositioning Libraries : Exploring, Engaging and Expanding for Next Gen Library Users*” from December 14-16, 2022. The three days’ online conference was attended by 2200 participants from various parts of India and many other countries. It was the best ever participation of professionals at the NACLIN Conference and especially on the special occasion of the Silver Jubilee of NACLIN Conference.

NACLIN 2022 was inaugurated online on December 14, 2022 by the Chief Guest Professor Saket Kushwaha, Vice-Chancellor, Rajiv Gandhi University, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh. The Guest of Honour address was delivered by Dr. Vinita S. Sahay, Director, Indian Institute of Management Bodh Gaya, Bihar. Shri K. Jayakumar, President, DELNET delivered the Presidential address.
