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I INTRODUCTION

The year 2024-25 has been a year of notable achievements, steady progress and purposeful transformation across key priority areas for DELNET. The year has witnessed significant milestones in the institutional journey of DELNET. There was an expansion in its resources, membership, setting up of new offices, imparting new skillsets to the LIS professionals, faculty members, etc. through its programmes, webinars, new initiatives enhancing national and international collaboration and cooperation with the member-institutions. It was made possible with the collective commitment and unwavering cooperation of the member-institutions. DELNET's dedicated vision and mission to network libraries and to empower LIS professionals and the users' community with the best resources and services remains its driving force during 2024-25.

DELNET remains committed to foster connections and collaborations among the member-institutions and to strengthen the resource sharing. The accessibility, discoverability, affordability, equitability and inclusivity of resources, services for diverse group of library users remains priority areas of focus for DELNET. It is committed to work proactively for the libraries of member-institutions and to make them future-ready and relevant for the generations to come.

II MEMBERSHIP

The year 2024-25 was among the best ever year on the membership front as DELNET brought 830 new members under its library networking umbrella, further widening its coverage of institutions and reach of its resources and services. These new members joined from across the country. The states from where the maximum number of members joined included Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Kerala, etc.

DELNET continued with its dedicated efforts to increase its membership by approaching various universities, colleges and specialised institutions in India. Besides the New Delhi office, the Coordination Units also helped in the membership drive by approaching the institutions in their respective states/regions. The detailed breakup of DELNET Membership is mentioned in Appendix I.

III FINANCE

DELNET with its modest approach and self-sustainable model is striving and thriving, committed to provide affordable access to its vast networked knowledge resources and services to its member-institutions. It is a unique and inspiring cooperative model, wherein through the meagre finances generated through the only source, i.e. the membership fee which has not been increased for more than two decades (GST applicable since July 1, 2017), DELNET is able to consistently expand its library networking horizons, benefiting its member-libraries.

IV DELNET BUILDING

4.1 DELNET Hostel Block

During the year 2024-25, DELNET hostel block/ guest house facilities at New Delhi were regularly used by institutions from across the country for accommodation, organising meetings, interviews, seminars, workshops, etc. It is most popular among the institutions. These facilities, services and support offered by DELNET were greatly admired by the institutions. Many renowned institutions located across the country availed themselves of the facilities at DELNET.

The property tax for 2024 for DELNET, New Delhi was paid to the MCD. Also the property tax for DELNET Bengaluru, Lucknow and Pune offices were paid.

4.2 Inauguration of DELNET Pune Office

We are pleased to inform members that the DELNET Pune office at O-445, Boulevard Towers, Phase I, Connaught Road, Sadhu Vaswani Road, Pune-411001 was inaugurated on January 23, 2025 by Shri K. Jayakumar, President, DELNET. Dr. P. R. Goswami, Treasurer, DELNET, other DELNET officials and a number of professionals from Maharashtra attended the in-person programme. We are glad to mention that the DELNET Pune office started its operations from the new premises since February 1, 2025. It contributes significantly to strengthening the DELNET activities in the state of Maharashtra.

4.3 DELNET Lucknow Office – Interior Work

The Interior work at the DELNET Lucknow Office located at Shalimar Iridium, Opp. Indira Gandhi Pratishthan, Vibhuti Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh is currently in progress. The electrical, networking, air-conditioning and false ceiling work has been completed. It is hoped that the new DELNET Lucknow office will be made operational with staff soon.

4.4 Purchase of DELNET Vadodara Office

We are pleased to inform members that DELNET has purchased a fully furnished 1668 sq. ft. carpet area office space located at Office Nos. 309, 310, 311, 312, 3rd Floor, Neptune Edge, Sarabhai Campus, Near Genda Circle, Vadiwadi, Vadodara-390023, Gujarat for setting up its Vadodara office to provide proactive support to its member-institutions in Gujarat.

V NETWORK OPERATIONS

DELNET Online Services and Digital Network Infrastructure

During the year 2024-25, DELNET online services were operational 24/7 to ensure a seamless access to its resources by the users of its member-institutions. The access was made through static IPs as well as through Login/Password.

The two Internet links, i.e. 2 Mbps leased line of DELNET-NIC and 20 Mbps Airtel connectivity worked well during the year.

VI DELNET DISCOVERY PORTAL

6.1 It is worth mentioning that the member institutions of DELNET greatly utilised the DELNET discovery portal for accessing more than 4.2 crore resources of various member-libraries. It is of immense help for faculty, researchers and scholars for their academic, research and scholarly needs.

We may also highlight that in the usage statistics report an additional feature of generating the usage report by “Resource Access” was added in addition to “System Access”. This helps the libraries to know the types of resources being used by their faculty and students.

Furthermore, the most effective Inter Library Loan and Document Delivery Services were also availed of by member-libraries which helps the member-institutions immensely to meet their requirements for academic, research and reference in a timely manner. The libraries also contribute their records for merging in DELNET Portal and were benefited. The member-institutions participate actively in the resource sharing activities.

6.2 Knowledge Gainer Portal

The Knowledge Gainer Portal provides an access to more than 1.6 crore full-text E-books, E-journals, E-articles, etc. which were used extensively by member-libraries during the year.

6. LANGUAGE LEARNING Portal
- The portal is used for improving the spoken and writing skills in English and other foreign languages. The students from member-institutions used it extensively. On the demand of the member-institutions, the resources on Hindi learning was also added during the year which is used to capacity by the foreign students.
7. MANUSCRIPTS AND RARE BOOKS
- DELNET provides access to full text manuscripts and rare books.
8. E-NEWSPAPERS
- The DELNET “E-Newspapers” section in the Online Portal provides an access to many E-newspapers published in Hindi, English and other regional languages.
9. E-JOURNALS STATISTICS : SUBJECT-WISE [New]
- DELNET has made “E-journals Statistics : Subject-wise” available to member-libraries. The details including the Impact factor, indexing information, ISSN of E-journals are made available. There are separate listings of National and International E-journals. This is of great use by the member-institutions.

VII INTER-LIBRARY LOAN (ILL) AND DOCUMENT DELIVERY SERVICES (DDS)

The Inter-Library and Document Delivery Services continues to remain as highly relevant and used services of DELNET during the year 2024-25. The physical copies of books were arranged through Inter Library Loan and also the select journal articles. These timely services by DELNET are highly appreciated by member-institutions. The DELNET, New Delhi and its Coordination Units provides a proactive support to the member-institutions.

VIII DELNET PPP Initiative

During the year 2024-25, DELNET launched a special *PPP (Participate, Promote and Progress) Initiative for Strengthening Knowledge Sharing, Innovation and Research Among its Member-Institutions*. Under this new PPP initiative, the member-institutions were requested to come forward in adopting new innovative best practices in their respective institutions which will go a long way in realising the envisioned roles of libraries and to empower its users' community. A very detailed communication was sent to member-institutions and DELNET received a favourable response from member libraries. DELNET also sent a poster of "DELNET Digital Knowledge Hub" to the member-institutions and requested them to create an exclusive space for the library users to access DELNET online resources.

IX SOFTWARE SUPPORT

9.1 DELNET during the year 2024-25 continued to offer Delplus software free of charge for library automation to the members which has gained wider popularity. DELNET undertakes remote installation of the software and also helps in migrating the existing records (from Access/Excel) in addition to generating Barcodes for the member-institutions. The software has user-friendly modules including Acquisition, Cataloguing, Circulation, OPAC, etc. adhering to library standards which are appreciated by the institutions. It helps in the modernisation of libraries.

9.2 Support for Open Source Software for Member-Institutions

DELNET also offered support for open source software. The requests for installation of Koha and DSpace were received periodically from the member-institutions. DELNET undertakes the remote installation work for Koha and DSpace. The non-availability of trained manpower in Linux in libraries was a major deterrent for the non-adoption of open source software.

11.1 DELNET'S ViSiOn Portal of Video Lectures

We are glad to inform members that ViSiOn (Video Sites Online) Portal gained popularity during 2024-25 among the member-institutions as it contains a number of enriching video lectures delivered by the Subject Matter Experts (SMEs), Faculty Members, etc. in varied fields of knowledge. 25426 video lectures are currently available through the ViSiOn portal. A number of member-institutions have contributed the video lectures of their own faculty. We request the members to continuously contribute for the portal.

11.2 DELNET Online Courses Portal (COnCour)

We are pleased to mention that the COnCour Portal (COnCour - Continue with Online Courses to Conquer Your Future Now) which provides details of more than 4800 Online Courses in various disciplines provided through various institutions (both national and international) was used by the Students, Faculty and also LIS professionals. The courses can be searched through Subject, Certificate Granting Institutions, Title of the Course, Country, etc. It is further informed that the portal was effectively used by the students and other users of member-libraries and generating interest among the students' community.

11.3 New Portals

GRIP (Global Research and Innovation Portal)

We are glad to inform members that the "GRIP - Global Research and Innovation Portal" is made live for member-institutions. The metadata of more than 15,000 Research

Reports of Indian Research organisations (NIRF ranked) have been compiled so far. It will strengthen the research and innovation ecosystem in the institutions and also lead to enhancing research collaborations and knowledge sharing among researchers and institutions. The portal is updated regularly DELNET urges its members to contribute their Research Reports to the portal.

It is also to inform that “GRIP” (Global Research and Innovation Portal)” is registered under Certificate of Registration of Trademark under class 42 for 10 years period.

11.4 Portal on Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS)

We wish to inform members that DELNET has begun working on developing a dedicated Portal on “Indian Knowledge Systems”. The portal designing work and data curation activities are currently in progress.

11.5 Portal on Museums

DELNET has also started developing a portal highlighting the museums located in India and other countries with a special focus on the collection coverage and uniqueness of resources, etc. It will help to promote our rich cultural heritage and will be of immense help to researchers and scholars.

11.6 DrillBit: Plagiarism Detection Software for Academic Integrity

We are pleased to inform members that DELNET has signed a MOU with DrillBit and offer subscription to Web-based DrillBit Software to its member-libraries for plagiarism detection for an annual subscription of Rs 48,000 (inclusive of GST) for 300 documents checking and Rs. 70,800 (inclusive of GST) for checking 500 documents. A number of member-institutions are subscribing to it.

We wish to inform members that the DELNET’s Coordination Units at Bengaluru and Pune coordinated well for Inter Library Loan, conducting training sessions, the data collection, follow-up for membership renewals, new membership, etc. from the region during the year.

XIII NATIONAL INITIATIVES

NACLIN 2024

We are pleased to inform our members that the 27th National Convention on Knowledge, Library and Information Networking – NACLIN 2024 on the theme “Smart Libraries: Inspiring, Engaging, Enabling and Connecting Users, Communities for Building Knowledge Societies” was organised by DELNET-Developing Library Network, New Delhi in collaboration with Medi-Caps University, Indore at Hotel Sayaji, Indore from September 25-27, 2024. Nearly 250 participants from different parts of India including Library experts, librarians, LIS professionals, students, exhibitors, product demonstrators

actively participated in the Conference. It was for the first time in the history of NACLIN that the Convention was held in the state of Madhya Pradesh. The city of Indore, having the proud distinction of being the cleanest city of India hosted the Conference.

The Inaugural function on September 25, 2024 began with an invocation of Saraswati Vandana by the students of Medi-Caps University, Indore. It was followed by the lighting of the lamp marking the inauguration of NACLIN 2024 by the Chief Guest Dr. Ram S. Shrivastava, Chairman, Maharaja Ranjit Singh College of Professional Sciences (MRSCPS) Indore and a well-known physicist and an academician, in the esteemed presence of Shri K. Jayakumar, President, DELNET (former Chief Secretary, Kerala and Jt Secretary, Ministry of Culture, Government of India); Prof. (Dr.) Dilip K. Patnaik, Vice-Chancellor, Medi-Caps University, Indore; Dr. Sangeeta Kaul, Director, DELNET & Organising Secretary, NACLIN 2024 and Dr. Anurag Kumar Khare, Librarian, Medi-Caps University, Indore and Co-Organising Secretary, NACLIN 2024.

The welcome address was jointly delivered by Dr Sangeeta Kaul and Dr. Anurag Kumar Khare. The special address was delivered by Prof. (Dr.) Dilip K. Patnaik, Vice-Chancellor, Medi-Caps University, Indore. He lauded the efforts of DELNET in organising NACLIN 2024 at Indore and expressed his gratitude for choosing Medi-Caps University, Indore as its partner for organising the Convention. Prof. Patnaik made an impressive, inquisitive statement “You know what you know, but you don’t know what you don’t know”. He said that library professionals have to play a crucial role in discovering the unknown and to offer help for the betterment of the society. He observed that the roles of the LIS professionals are not just to safeguard the assets but to be prepared for the new emerging roles. He further emphasised that professionals needs to do smart work and hard work in the libraries to meet the growing demands of the users community. He also urged the need for sharing the best practices among the professionals. Dr. Patnaik said that the world has moved from the technology era to the social era and the libraries have to become vibrant places of interaction and places of learning.

It was followed by the release of NACLIN 2024 pre-conference publication containing 21 papers of the Conference, edited by Dr. Sangeeta Kaul and Dr. Anurag Kumar Khare and also the NACLIN souvenir was released on the occasion by the Chief Guest Dr. Ram S. Shrivastava, Chairman, Maharaja Ranjit Singh College of Professional Sciences (MRSCPS) Indore.

Dr. Shrivastava delivered the inaugural Chief Guest address. He dwelt at length on the genesis of computing technologies to the world of learning and spoke about his long time association with Holkar Science College, Indore. Dr. Shrivastava highlighted the difficulties which were encountered by the researchers and scholars some 3-4 decades ago wherein arranging the references through mechanical document delivery only which was very expensive in those days and times. He appreciated the path-breaking efforts of DELNET in establishing a digital library network which the distinguished Chief Guest felt that it is in line with the vision of ‘Atma Nirbhar Bharat’

of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. Dr. Shrivastava stressed the fact that information and technology must reach each and every citizen in the country. He also shared an interesting fact that 2.5 billion research papers were published last year and the top contributing countries are USA, Russia, China, Japan, Germany, India and France. He said that more than 95 per cent of the research papers are in their regional languages, whereas in India nearly 99.9 per cent of the publications are in English language only. He urged the need to empower the regional languages in India. The chief guest concluded the address stating that the future is of quantum computation.

It was followed by the Presidential Address by Shri K. Jayakumar, President, DELNET. He said that it is an immensely happy occasion for DELNET to organise NACLIN 2024 as it is growing from strength to strength. He affirmed that NACLIN serves an intelligent purpose for Library and Information Science professionals. He appreciated the resounding response received from the LIS fraternity with a massive participation of professionals. Shri K. Jayakumar said that NACLIN is a learning process for DELNET. Every NACLIN indicates the vision and mission of DELNET and DELNET feels extremely honoured that the library professionals appreciate the functioning and services of DELNET. He added that we are happy to be in a much celebrated city of Indore as every city in India compares them with Indore for being the cleanest city. He further emphasised that in a world where knowledge is capital and data is treasure, the task of the library professionals is under constant change. He concluded his Presidential address by mentioning that NACLIN urges all of us to be eternally vigilant and innovative and to be constantly aware of the changing contours of technology, challenges of information management, hitherto unknown opportunities, threat of obsolescence and the value of constructive involvement. He wished everyone a great learning experience and exploring the widened increasing opportunities for the benefit of the libraries and library professionals.

The inaugural function ended with the Vote of Thanks by Dr. Sangeeta Kaul, Director, DELNET.

It was followed by the Inauguration of NACLIN 2024 Exhibition wherein a number of leading companies exhibited their products and services. It included Balani Group, New Delhi; Beegees Computers Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai; Cyber Peace Foundation, New Delhi; Drillbit, Bengaluru; Gale, A Cengage Company, New Delhi; New Age International; RapidRadio Solutions Private Limited, Ahmedabad; M/s Spacious Book House, New Delhi and Trestle Labs, Bengaluru.

The first tutorial on “Emerging Trends and Technologies in Library and Information Services” was conducted by Dr. Nabi Hasan, Librarian & Head, IIT Delhi. The session was most enlightening, engaging and empowering and was greatly valued and appreciated by the participants.

It was followed by product demonstration by Balani Infotech Pvt. Ltd. Conducted by Mr. Anurag Gupta, Territory Manager (West) and Ms. Priyanka Harne, Product Associates. The presentation on Gale, A Cengage Company was conducted by Mr.

Utkarsh Shrivastava, Sales Manager, North India and and Mr. Micky Mehta, Digital Product Trainer. The second tutorial on “Redesigning Library Spaces of Smart Libraries” was conducted by Dr. Sangeeta Kaul, Director, DELNET.

DELNET has included a new feature in NACLIN 2024, i.e. NACLIN 2024-Ideathon-Best Ideas on the topic “Smart Libraries”, “Smart Technologies” and “Smart Librarians”. The session Expert Jury Members were Dr. P.R. Goswami, Former Director (Libraries), Ministry of Culture, Government of India, New Delhi; Dr. Vivek Patkar, Independent Researcher, Mumbai and Dr. Anurag Kumar Khare, Librarian, Medi-Caps University, Indore. The session witnessed the impressive participation from the participants and it was truly a knowledge sharing session. The three best ideas were selected in each category, i.e. Smart Libraries, Smart Technologies and Smart Librarians. The professionals who shared their best ideas included : for Smart Libraries : Mr Tapesh Sinha, DESIDOC; Ms. Sarita Waghate (Brahmos) and Mr. Sumit Sundar Ray, IIM Indore. For Smart Technologies – Mr. Tapesh Sinha (DESIDOC), Dr. K. Adhinarayana (Bharatidasan Institute of Management) and Mr Sumit Sundar Ray (IIM Indore). For the Smart Librarians category the best ideas were given by Ms. Sarita Waghate (Brahmos), Mr. Amitabh Saran (formerly with Allahabad High Court) and Ms. Priyatama Sharma (Azim Premji University, Bhopal).

In the evening, all the participants were taken to Nakhrali Dhani, Indore for a cultural evening. It was followed by a networking dinner and a musical evening which was enjoyed by everyone.

On the second day of NACLIN 2024, the first Technical Session was devoted to ‘Emerging Trends and Technologies in Libraries and Cyber Security Concerns. The session was chaired by Dr. J. K. Pattnaik, Scientific Officer ‘F’, Incharge Library, SIRC, Raja Ramanna Centre for Advanced Technology (RRCAT), Indore and Rapporteur of the session was Ms. Sushma Zutshi, Librarian, Centre for Air Power Studies, New Delhi. The first keynote paper entitled “Emerging Trends and Technologies in Libraries: An Overview” was presented by Dr. M. G. Sreekumar, Director Libraries, Jio Institute, Panvel, Dist. Raigad, Maharashtra. The second keynote presentation of the session was delivered online by Major Vineet Kumar, Founder and Global President, Cyber Peace Foundation. Mrs Anindita Mishra, Senior Consultant and Master Trainer, CPF was present in-person. The last keynote paper of the session entitled “Kibo: Transforming Libraries with AI-Technology to Overcome Barriers of Literacy, Language and Disability” was delivered by Ms. Akshita Sachdeva and Mr. Bonny Dave, Co-founders, Directors, Trestle Labs, Kibo. The paper entitled “Harnessing the Power of Python for Data Mining in Libraries” was presented by Ms. Rachna Patnaik, Scientist/Engineer SG and Head, Library & Knowledge Management Division, Space Applications Centre, ISRO, Ahmedabad. Another paper entitled “SciSpace Copilot: Accrediting Research Through Artificial Intelligence: A Case Study Conducted” was delivered by Dr. Bipin B. Nargide, Assistant Librarian, Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics (Deemed University), Pune. The paper entitled “Artificial Intelligence (AI) Applications in Libraries: A Bibliometric Analysis from the Indian Perspectives” written by Dr. Prafulla Kumar

Mahanta, Librarian, Digboi College, Digboi, Tinsukia, Assam; Mr. Dulumani Sarma, Librarian, Habraghat Mahavidyalaya, Krishnai Goalpara, Assam and Dr. Tripti Gogoi, Assistant Professor, DLISc, Somaiya Vidyavihar University, Mumbai was presented by Dr. Tripti Gogoi. The paper entitled “The Role of Discovery Tools and Technologies in Modern Libraries: Revolutionising Information Access and Review of Discovery Tools Available at DESIDOC” written by Mr. Tapesha Sinha, Scientist ‘F’; Mrs. Dipti Arora, Technical Officer ‘C’ and Dr. K. Nageswara Rao, Scientist ‘G’ and Director, Defence Scientific Information and Documentation Centre (DESIDOC), DRDO, Ministry of Defence, Delhi was presented by Mr. Tapesha Sinha. The paper entitled “Metaverse Libraries: Opportunities and Challenges for the Differently Abled Patrons” was delivered by Ms. Sarika Praveen Agale, Library Incharge, Symbiosis Institute of International Business, (SIIB), Symbiosis International Deemed University, Pune. The last paper of technical session I entitled “Smart Library Services: The Impact of QR Codes at TMI Learning Resource Centre, Pune” was presented by Dr. Rahul Viswe, Librarian, Tolani Maritime Institute, Pune.
